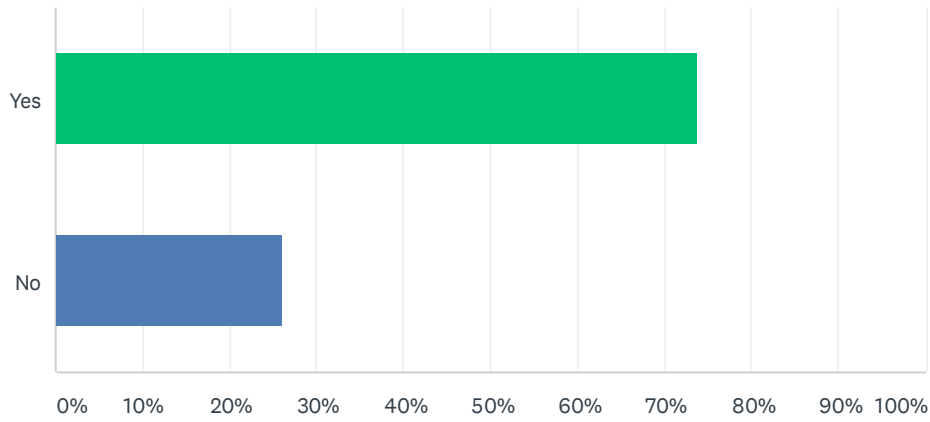


# Q1 Have you ever participated in an online Zoom meeting?

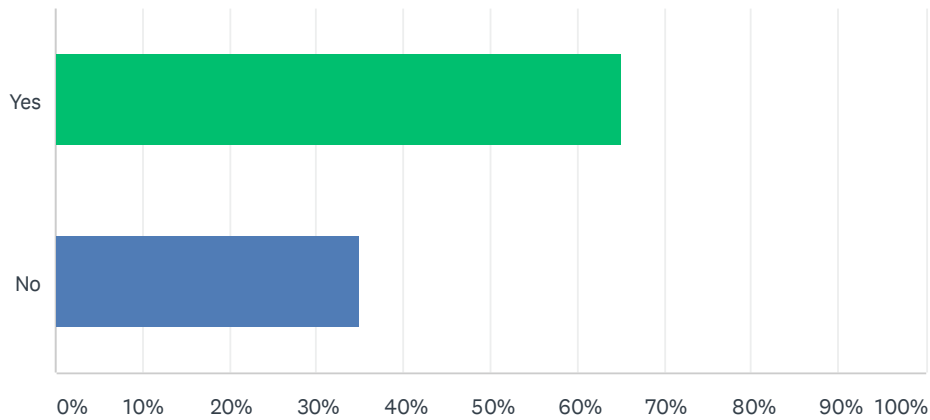

Answered: 63 Skipped: 2

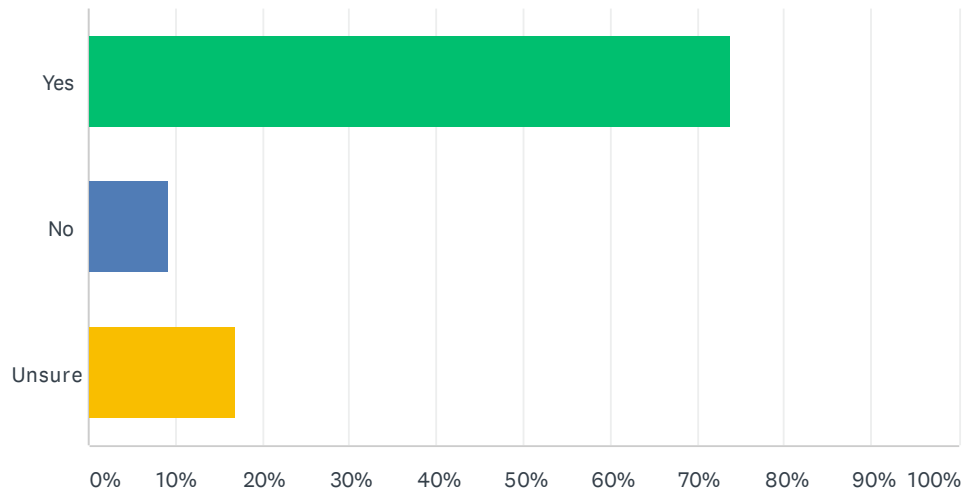

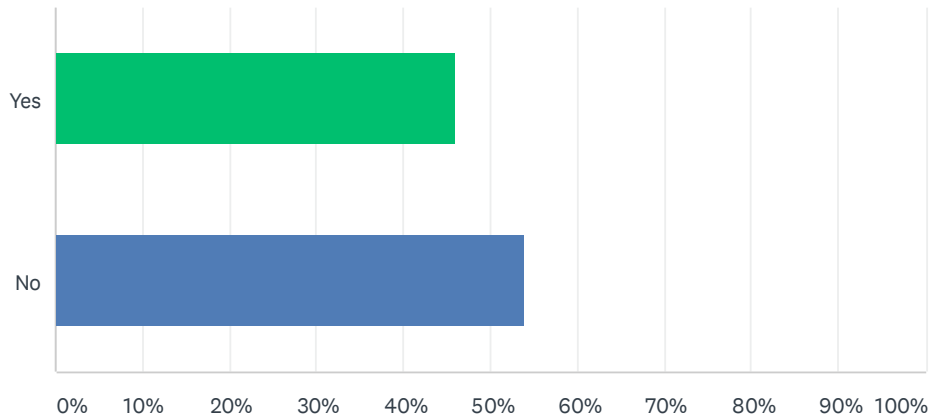
